



Dawson Forest Canoe Trips on the Etowah!

The Upper Etowah River Alliance is offering canoe trips on the Etowah River from 10am until 4pm. The dates this year are:

May 1, June 12 & October 23, 2010

Spend the day enjoying the Beauty of the Etowah canoeing from the Highway 9 Put-in to the Kelly Bridge Take-out in Dawson County near Dawsonville. Canoes and equipment will be provided by Appalachian Outfitters (www.canoegeorgia.com). Minimal experience is necessary. Canoes can hold two adults and one child. Kayaks may also be available. The cost is \$25 per paddler, with a maximum charge of \$50 per canoe. If you bring your own canoe, the cost will be \$15.

The trip will take us through Dawson Forest, a beautiful and quiet stretch of the Etowah River with no cars or houses to distract you from the natural scenery. If the water level is right maybe we'll get out and check out the critters in the water. Space is limited. Sign-up today.
